

RING SIZE GUIDE

Finding the perfect ring size ensures comfort and security. If you're measuring your finger or using a ring you already own, follow the simple methods below to determine your ideal size.

Method 1: Measure Your Finger

This is the most accurate method when purchasing a new ring. You'll Need:

- A flexible measuring tape, or
- A strip of paper or piece of string
- A ruler (if using paper or string)

Step 1: Wrap the measuring tape, paper strip, or string around the finger where you intend to wear your ring. If you plan to stack rings, measure the exact position where the ring will sit.

Step 2: Mark the point where the ends overlap, ensuring the fit is snug but comfortable.

Step 3: Lay the paper or string flat and measure the length in millimetres (mm). This measurement is your finger circumference.

Step 4: Compare your measurement with the ring size chart below to find your corresponding UK, EU, and US ring size.

Method 2: Measure an Existing Ring

If you already own a ring that fits perfectly, this method is quick and reliable.

Step 1: Select a ring that comfortably fits the intended finger.

Step 2: Using a ruler or digital caliper, measure the inside diameter of the ring in millimetres. Measure straight across the centre from one inside edge to the other.

Step 3: Match the inside diameter to the closest measurement in the size chart.
